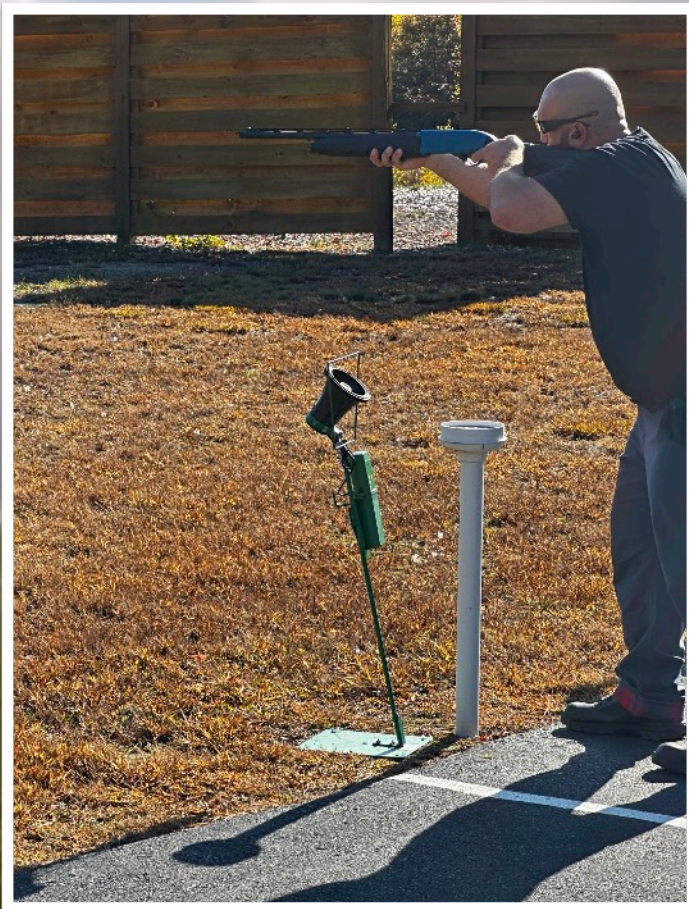
This year, the October 2024 shoot attracted 25 shooters and 1 chicken.
