# Special Notices -

The use of "steel core" or "armor piercing" ammunition is strictly prohibited on any rifle or pistol range at the club.

The use of steel "shot" is permitted on shotgun fields.

The use of "bump fire" equipped or fully automatic weapons is strictly <u>prohibited</u> on any range at the club.

Patterning of shotguns is **NOT** allowed on the rifle or pistol ranges, nor is it allowed on the Skeet, Trap or 5-Stand fields. It **IS** allowed in the area that has been designated for that purpose to the left of Trap Field 2.

**GUEST ACCESS REMINDER** – Members are allowed to bring a non-member to the rifle/pistol ranges **ONLY** if that person has been to the club fewer than **2 times**. After 2 visits to the club, the guest must either join, or no longer use the rifle/pistol ranges.

NOTE if your guest has taken a class with Tactical Dynamics, those classes count as a "visit" by your guest.

Members who violate this rule may be subject to temporary or possibly permanent membership suspension.

The guest visit rule does not pertain to spouses or member's children under the age of 18.



- If you have ANY symptoms that could be related to the Coronavirus or if you think you have been exposed to someone who has the virus; DO NOT come to the club!
- If you are a vulnerable individual by age group or if you have underlying medical conditions, please give careful consideration before visiting the club.
- For the time being the club is **open only to members**. No guests allowed. However, members may continue to bring their spouse and/or their children who are under the age of 19 to the club.
- Please observe proper social distancing by maintaining separation of at least six feet.
- Face coverings are recommended at all times. If 6 feet of separation cannot be maintained face coverings are required. Face coverings are required to enter the warmup house.
- The shotgun warm up house is open for restroom use. But no gatherings are allowed in the warm up house. Face coverings are required to enter. Please disinfect the restroom after use.
- Paying for your shotgun rounds will be on the honor system. Please bring exact change, since no change can be provided. A locked cash box and signup sheet will be located outside the warmup house. Clearly print your name, number of rounds shot, and your payment amount on the sheet. Deposit your cash payment in the locked box.
- Please pick up and dispose of your own hulls so that others need not handle them.
- Prepare your equipment and assemble your shotgun at your vehicle.
- Limit the handling of the skeet control and disinfect after each use.
- Disinfectant and hand sanitizer will be made available, but members are encouraged to bring their own and use it.
- The warmup house porch may be used but social distancing is required.
- Shotgun squads are limited to no more than five.

5/1/2020 – Due to Coronavirus concerns and federal guidelines regarding limits on group gatherings, the May Board of Director's meeting will not be held in the clubhouse. Board members will still hold the meeting via an as yet un-chosen video/audio conferencing facility. 


